Racing to School

Teachers, pupils and their families taking part in the Arabian Rainbow competition are invited to join Racing To School, racing's education programme for school children. This will offer all pupils participating in the competition the chance to take part in a free event before racing.

For those which to enjoy this activity, we ask for pupils and families to be at the Weighing Room steps for 12:10. Guide to the activity:

Children will have access to areas normally restricted on a raceday (before racing starts).

Weighing Room Children will be given an insight into how racing works, and take part in some challenges linked to the Jockeys weights.

On Track Children will be taken onto the racecourse and discover more about distances used in racing, the photo finish

Final Furlong We will organise a race with a couple of different categories (age prob best) over the final furlong (dressed up in colours, good photo opportunity)

Arabian Rainbow Competition

The beautiful painted horses will be arranged outside around the parade ring (weather permitting). His Highness Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Deputy Ruler of Dubai will judge the Arabian Rainbow competition.
