

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT (Variation)

- 1. The name of the school is Longparish Church of England Primary School
- 2. The school is a Voluntary Aided school.
- The name of the governing body is The governing body of Longparish Church of England Primary School
- 4. The governing body shall consist of
 - a. 2 parent governors;
 - b. The head teacher unless the head teacher resigns the office of governor in accordance with regulation 19
 - c. 1 staff governor
 - d. 1 LA governor
 - e. 7 foundation governors
- 5. Total number of governors 12
- 6. The name of the foundation body entitled to appoint foundation governors is "The Diocesan Board of Education for the Winchester Diocese".
- 7. a. The holder of the following office(s) shall be foundation governor(s) ex officio: The principal officiating minister or St Nicholas' Church Longparish.
 - b. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry within which the school is situated shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21 (1) of the Regulations or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which this governorship exists.
- 8. "The Diocesan Board of Education for the Winchester Diocese" is entitled to request the removal of any ex officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
- 9. There is a Trust Deed for Longparish Church of England Primary School which is dated 14th March 1903. The Rector and Churchwardens are the school's Trustees.
- 10. The Ethos of the school is described as follows:
 - At Longparish Church of England Primary School we are committed to providing a high

- quality education based on the principles and practices of the Church of England in a challenging, stimulating and caring environment
- 11. This Instrument of Government comes into effect on 3 February 2015
- 12. This Instrument was made by order of Hampshire Local Authority on 18 December 2014.
- 13. A copy of this Instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the headteacher is not a governor), any trustees and to the appropriate religious body.
