



## **INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT (Variation)**


1. The name of the school is Longparish Church of England Primary School
2. The school is a Voluntary Aided school.
3. The name of the governing body is The governing body of Longparish Church of England Primary School
4. The governing body shall consist of
  - a. 2 parent governors;
  - b. The head teacher unless the head teacher resigns the office of governor in accordance with regulation 19
  - c. 1 staff governor
  - d. 1 LA governor
  - e. 7 foundation governors
5. Total number of governors 12
6. The name of the foundation body entitled to appoint foundation governors is "The Diocesan Board of Education for the Winchester Diocese".
7.
  - a. The holder of the following office(s) shall be foundation governor(s) ex officio: The principal officiating minister or St Nicholas' Church Longparish.
  - b. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry within which the school is situated shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21 (1) of the Regulations or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which this governorship exists.
8. "The Diocesan Board of Education for the Winchester Diocese" is entitled to request the removal of any ex officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
9. There is a Trust Deed for Longparish Church of England Primary School which is dated 14<sup>th</sup> March 1903. The Rector and Churchwardens are the school's Trustees.
10. The Ethos of the school is described as follows:

At Longparish Church of England Primary School we are committed to providing a high

quality education based on the principles and practices of the Church of England in a challenging, stimulating and caring environment

11. This Instrument of Government comes into effect on 3 February 2015
12. This Instrument was made by order of Hampshire Local Authority on 18 December 2014.
13. A copy of this Instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body ( and the headteacher is not a governor), any trustees and to the appropriate religious body.
